## Following through on the Farm to Fork and Green Deal commitments as regards the Animal Welfare legislative revision

Dear Commissioner Von der Leyen,

We, the Members of the Animal Welfare Intergroup of the European Parliament, would like to reiterate the importance of the revision of the EU Animal Welfare legislation, in line with the Commission's Farm to Fork Strategy and the Green Deal. The Animal Welfare Intergroup welcomes this revision and trusts the publication of the four proposals will come this autumn.

As you are certainly aware, DG SANTE is in the process of re-submitting its Impact Assessment of the Fitness Check to the Regulatory Scrutiny Board and we trust DG SANTE will be provided with the necessary assistance with its resubmission to ensure the publication of ambitious proposals.

Following the Fitness Check, the current legislation on animal welfare was found to not be fit for purpose. Scientific understanding of animal welfare and the sustainability of our food systems has evolved since the current legislation was adopted and as such, EU citizens demand higher standards when it comes to animal welfare. Members of the European Parliament have echoed this demand in its various resolutions and own initiative reports.

The cost of improving animal welfare is largely outweighed by the cost of our inaction. A <u>recent</u> <u>study</u> by the Impact Institute found that the external costs of EU animal sourced production and consumption are on average 7.7 times higher than their economic value. The main drivers of such high external cost are low animal welfare, diet-related disease, air pollution, and land use.
